Check-In 6:30pm

- Check-In will take place in Museum Lobby
- Groups may check-in once all group members have arrived.
- Only One leader may check-in your group

- Sleeping Arrangements
- Name tags

Camp-In Rules & Guidelines

- Chaperones must accompany and supervise their group at all times
- Shoes must be worn at all times
- Smoking is not permitted
- Campers are responsible for cleaning their "campsite" area
- The Museum is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Camp-In participation is limited to the campers identified during check-in, No siblings allowed.

Packing List

- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Hair brush/comb
- Flashlights
- Air mattress or mattress pad
- Dress in layers, Museum temperature varies
- Bring comfortable clothing and shoes.

All gear is limited to the size of ONE garbage bag per camper

Do Not Bring

- Any electrical devices (example: hair dryer, curling iron, radios, mp3 player, iPods, PSP, Nintendo DS etc.)

Food

- The Museum provides a pizza dinner, late night snack and light breakfast to campers and chaperones.
- Group leaders must bring food for campers with special dietary needs.
