## SHIP TOUR CONFIRMATION

*There are many tours being given at the same time as yours. In order to expedite your ship tour and avoid delays, please read carefully. The following information will help make your tour a pleasant experience for everyone.*

### **ENTRANCE:**

It is suggested that you enter Port Everglades from I-595 through the Eller Drive Entrance. Your photo ID (drivers license or passport) will be checked at this entrance. Please be prepared to show them this letter. It will expedite the process if the group leader collects and presents photo ID's for everyone 18 and over in the same vehicle. Proceed east on Eller Drive (becomes SE 10<sup>th</sup> Ave) toward terminals 21 – 26 to another check point (US Navy) and show this letter. They will direct you to the parking and/or terminals.

### **PARKING:**

CARS / VANS: There is paid parking in the Mid-Port parking Garage (see attached map). ALL cars/vans MUST park in the Mid-Port parking Garage (\$2 < 1 hr, \$5 < 5 hrs)

BUSES: Park at Terminal 26 after dropping passengers at terminal 24 (see attached map)

### **CHECK – IN (Terminal 24):**

Check-in at Terminal 24 at least fifteen minutes prior to the tour. All visitors enter through Terminal 24. All adults (18 and over) will be required to show a picture I.D. In the case of student groups, the group leader will also be required to present a list of all students. Everyone must pass through magnometers and all bags will be checked. Your group will wait in a "holding" area marked by the ship's name. Once the entire group has gathered, 2 sailors will escort the group through the terminal and onto the designated ship.

**MISC:**

Appropriate dress is pants and low, rubberized soles, no high heels. Oversized bags are discouraged as you will need to climb up and down the very narrow and steep stairs/ladders in the ships (both hands required).

Please note that the ships are not handicap accessible – YOU MUST BE IN GOOD PHYSICAL CONDITION to navigate the steep stairs and ladders.

Cameras are permitted.

Souvenirs from the ships will be available for cash sale in the terminal 21 overhang area. Please visit this area after your tour to insure that you have free use of your hands during the tour.

Restroom facilities are limited .... A few portable toilets near the ships and two restrooms in the terminal 24 "holding area" (after you go through security).

After the tour is complete (approximately 45 minutes) guests will be escorted off the ship and to the nearest gate where they can proceed to the souvenir area, their cars or to Terminal 25 to meet their buses.

**PROHIBITED ITEMS (include):**

Firearms (you will be subject to arrest, even with a permit, anywhere within the port)  
Umbrellas  
Liquids

**SCHOOL TOURS:**

School buses proceed through the Port checkpoints and go to Terminal 24 to drop passengers for "CHECK-IN". School Buses will park in Terminal 26. After the students complete the ship tour (approx. 45 min), they will be escorted off the ship to the nearest gate to exit the apron. They will then walk to terminal 26 where their bus will pick them up.
